FAST FACTS

When commencing a new academic qualification, it is necessary (also for existing students) to **register** on the website by accessing our homepage, clicking on ‘Apply Now’, and following the instructions. **You will immediately receive two confirmation emails.** One email is for information purposes, and the other contains your pro-forma invoice indicating the academic programme for which you are registering (including the subjects), its level on the National Qualifications Framework (NQF), and the fee.

Note that “Advanced Business English” (Module M7) forms part of the Postgraduate Diploma and must be undertaken web-based in the same quarter as your first chosen module of the PGDipPM programme.

A student may choose to complete either Module M4 or Module M6 in the coming quarter. He or she will then complete the web-based Advanced Business English module in conjunction with M4 or M6.

All Cranefield’s academic programmes are offered through technology-enhanced distance learning. Note that classes for all academic programmes are streamed live on the Internet. These classes are accessible to students anywhere in the

world, including South Africa, through technology-enhanced distance learning. Classes are streamed for the AdvCertPM, AdvDipPM, PGDipPM and MComPM, while the PhD programme is completed on an individual basis.

Cranefield's Enhanced Distance Learning Mode of Delivery

As mentioned above, any student may choose to participate exclusively in online classes. Note that students who are in a time zone that renders live class participation difficult may instead study the recordings of the live classes streamed from Midrand.

Active participation in group assignments remains compulsory for all students. Students can meet physically or online in dedicated collaboration rooms where the entire group can see and hear each other in an organised fashion, using Cranefield's Blackboard Collaborate system. Such group sessions can also be recorded by students for revision purposes.
